A PROCLAMATION.

HIS Excellency the Right Honorable Viscount MONCK,
Governor General of the Dominion of CANADA,
having been pleased to constitute and appoint me to be
Lieutenant Governor of this Province of New Brunswick,
the Administration of the Government of which I have this
day assumed, I do therefore publish this Proclamation, of
which all Persons concerned are required to take due notice
and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and Seal at Fredericton, this
nineteenth day of October, in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven, and
in the thirty first year of Her Majesty's Reign.
