FROM and after the first day of next October, the *minimum average daily* attendance of pupils, that is, of pupils of six years of age and upwards, at each and every School in UPPER SACKVILLE or the village of Sackville, extending from one mile below the Academy to one mile above the "Four-corners," so called, or a mile above Kinnear's Corner, in the County of Westmorland, must be at least seventeen, to entitle the Teachers of such Schools to the Provincial allowance.
