

CAP. XXV.

An Act in further amendment of an Act for establishing and maintaining a General Public Hospital in the City and County of Saint John.

Passed 21st April, 1869.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—

That a copy of the annual statement, in detail, of the state and condition, affairs and transactions of the General Public Hospital in Saint John, required by the tenth Section of the twenty fifth Victoria, Chapter 42, to be transmitted to the Provincial Secretary for the information of the Governor in Council and the Legislature, shall be laid before the General Sessions of the Peace for the City and County of Saint John at the March Term thereof, and shall be submitted to the Grand Jury attending such Sessions, with the Parish and County Accounts, for their investigation, and for this purpose such copy shall be filed annually with the Clerk of the Peace between first day of January and the first day of March in each and every year.

CAP. XXVI.

An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Fredericton Hotel Company.

Passed 21st April, 1869.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—

That it shall and may be lawful for the said Fredericton Hotel Company, for all shares of the said Company not heretofore disposed of which shall be subscribed and taken up after the passing of this Act, to issue stock certificates bearing a guaranteed dividend or rate of interest of eight per centum upon the amount paid upon such shares; and such stock subscribed for after the passing of this Act as aforesaid shall be preference stock, and the dividend expressed to be due and payable by the said certificates shall be and form a first charge upon such part of the revenue of the said Company as shall be available for distribution among the stockholders.

CAP. XXVII.

An Act to repeal an Act made and passed in the thirty first year of the Reign of Queen Victoria, intituled "*An Act relating to the Central Bank of New Brunswick.*"

Passed 21st April, 1869.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—

That an Act made and passed in the thirty first year of the Reign of Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act relating to the Central Bank of New Brunswick*, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CAP. XXVIII.

An Act to continue the Act to incorporate the Fredericton Boom Company, and the several Acts in amendment thereof.

Passed 21st April, 1869.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—

That an Act made and passed in the seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Fredericton Boom Company*; also an Act made and passed in the eighth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act to amend an Act to incorporate the Fredericton Boom Company*; also an Act made and passed in the eleventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act further to amend and continue the Act to incorporate the Fredericton Boom Company*; also an Act made and passed in the eighteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled *An Act further to increase the capital stock, and to continue and amend the Act to incorporate the Fredericton Boom Company*, be and the said several Acts are hereby continued and declared to be in full force and effect until the first day of May, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety.

CAP. XXIX.

An Act to alter the time for holding the second semi-annual meeting of the County Council of the Municipality of Carleton.

Passed 21st April, 1869.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—

That the meeting of the County Council of the Municipality of Carleton, which is now by the second Section of the Act twenty fifth Victoria, Chapter 38, to be held on the first Tuesday in July in each and every year, shall hereafter be held on the last Tuesday in June in each and every year, any thing in the said Act to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.

CAP. XXX.

A Bill to alter the time of holding the County Court in the County of York.

Passed 21st April, 1869.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—

That the County Court in and for the County of York shall be holden on the second Tuesday in January in each and every year, instead of the first Tuesday in January, and on the third Tuesday in March in each and every year, instead of the first Tuesday in March as now provided for by Law.
