

The white light will be changed to a *fixed red* light, which in clear weather should be seen from a distance of 5 miles.

Alteration in Cape Sable Light.

Also, that from the first day of September, 1870, the following alteration will be made in Cape Sable Light, viz:—

The fixed red light will be changed to a *revolving white* light, showing *bright for fifteen seconds* and *eclipsed for twenty five seconds*.

Alteration in Baccaro Point Light.

Also, that from the first day of September, 1870, the following alteration will be made in the Light on Baccaro Point, west side of entrance of Latour Port, viz:—

The revolving white light will be changed to a *fixed red* light, which in clear weather should be seen from a distance of 12 miles.
