

The light is a *fixed red* light, elevated 44 feet above the level of high water, and in clear weather should be seen from the northern entrance of the Gut of Canso, which is 7 miles distant, and from the south (in consequence of the intervention of the land) about 3 miles.

The tower is square, 24 feet high, and painted white; it stands 117 feet from the extremity of the point, and its position is lat. 45° 36' 40" N., long. 61° 22' 0" west from Greenwich.
