

will be exhibited from a lighthouse recently erected on the north side of the north pier of Manistee Harbour, Lake Michigan.

The light will be a *fixed* white light, and in clear weather should be seen from a distance of 12 miles.

The illuminating apparatus is dioptric or by lenses of the fifth order.

The tower is 45 feet high, painted white, and attached to the keeper's dwelling; it is 19 yards from the channel side of the pier, and 287 yards from the middle point of the entrance.
