The Representatives of King's County regret they are unable to appropriate any sum whatever to the Bye Roads for this current year. The whole amount granted to King's County this year (\$6248-00) having been paid over to the Commissioner of the Board of Works, in part liquidation of the amounts advanced by him in previous years for the building of bridges. The Representatives would further state, that notwithstanding the transfer of the said sum of \$6248, the Bye Road fund of King's County will still be indebted to the Government in the sum of \$6261-69; a further advance of \$1895-25 being required this present year to pay off existing debts, as above set forth. In addition to this, the further sum of \$1400 will be due to A. Killam in 1872 and in 1873, on account of building certain Bridges,—all of which will appear by the Statement of Account hereinafter set forth.
