Lot.

1. Whenever any Association of not less than ten persons, either residents of the Province or non-residents, shall make application, declaring their intention of becoming actual Set-tlers under "The Free Grants Act 1872," each Associate shall have a lot located to him in any tract set apart under the provisions of the Act. And so soon as such Association shall have chopped down, piled and burned two acres on each Lot so assigned them, each Locatee shall be paid fifteen dollars; and the roads shall then be made to and through the Lots so located. 2. The Surveyor General shall prepare the necessary forms of Petition, Certificates, &c., to carry out the provisions of the above Act, and furnish them to all persons who may apply for them.
