THE following is a List of the Acts passed at the recent Session of the Legislature:—

An Act to provide for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government of the Province.

An Act to provide for the repair and improvement of Roads and Bridges, and other Public Works and services.

An Act to authorize the Town Council of the Town of Woodstock to raise money by way of loan, for the purchase of a Steam Fire Engine and apparatus, to erect an Engine House and build Tanks, and otherwise provide for the Fire Department of said Town.

An Act in addition to and in amendment of an Act to incorporate the Woodstock Pleasure Grounds Association.

An Act to enlarge the time within which an Execution may be issued on any final Judgment obtained in any Court of Record in this Province.

An Act relating to the Albert Railway Company.

An Act to authorize the Trustees of Saint Andrews Church, Chatham, to sell or otherwise dispose of their Manse and Manse land in the Town of Chatham, and reinvest the proceeds.

An Act to authorize the Trustees of Calvin Church in the City of Saint John, in connexion with the Presbyterian Church of New Brunswick, to sell and dispose of certain real estate in the said City.

An Act to incorporate the Albert and Westmorland Steam Navigation Company.

An Act in addition to and in further amendment of an Act to alter and amend the Act to incorporate the City of Fredericton.

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace in and for the County of King's County to assess the Parish of Kingston, in said County, for special purposes.

An Act to continue an Act to incorporate the Courtney Bay Bridge Company, and to decrease the capital stock thereof.

An Act to authorize the Town of Portland to raise money by way of loan, for the purchase of a Steam Fire Engine, and extension of the Fire Alarm Telegraph to the said Town.

An Act relating to Returns of Summary Convictions to be made by Justices of the Peace.

An Act in amendment of an Act intituled "An Act to incorporate certain districts of the Parish of Saint Stephen, in the County of Charlotte, to be known as the Town of Saint Stephen," and to authorize the Town Council to borrow money to pay off a debt due by the Fire Department of the said Town.

An Act in amendment of Chapter 96, Title xvii, of the Revised Statutes, 'Of the Survey and Exportation of Lumber.'

An Act to incorporate the Saint John, New Brunswick, Corresponding Committee of the Colonial and Continental Church Society.

An Act further to increase the Capital Stock of the Saint John Gas Light Company.

An Act to alter the time for holding the meeting of the proprietors of Oromocto Island.

An Act to alter the time for holding the March Term of the Court of General Sessions of the Peace for the County of King's County.
