## INSOLVENT ACT OF 1869.

In the matter of James E. Hamm, an Insolvent.

There will be sold at Public Auction, at Enniskillen Station, in the Parish of Petersville, in the County of Queen's, on SATURDAY the twenty fifth day of October next, at one o'clock in the forenoon,—

ALL the estate, right, title and interest of the above named Insolvent in the several Lots of Land and Premises described as follows:—

"All that certain lot, piece or parcel of Land situate, lying and being in the Parish of Petersville aforesaid, being part of a Lot granted by the Crown to one Linus Duplissea the twenty fifth day of September, A. D. 1868, under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, and distinguished as Lot number thirty eight (38), South Enniskillen, bounded as follows, that is to say—Beginning on the easterly line of said lot number thirty eight, at a point distant eighty rods from the southeasterly corner thereof; thence running by the magnet of the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty one along the said easterly line of said lot south thirty minutes east, the said distance of eighty rods, to a spruce tree at the southeast corner of said lot; thence north seventy eight degrees thirty minutes west fifteen chains and fifty links, or sixty two rods, to a spruce tree at the southwestern corner of said lot; thence north thirty minutes west eighty rods; and thence south seventy eight degrees thirty minutes east fifteen chains and fifty links, or sixty two rods, to the place of beginning; the said piece of land containing thirty acres more or less."
