Passed 25th March, 1873.

An Act to legalize and confirm the assessment of Rates and Taxes in the City of Fredericton for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy two.

An Act respecting the appointment of Notaries Public.

An Act relating to the Clerks of both Branches of the Legislature.

An Act relating to the assessment of Rates and Taxes within the Town of Woodstock.

An Act relating to the assessment of Rates and Taxes within the Town of Portland.

An Act to legalize the Assessment for School purposes made in and upon the City of Saint John for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy two.

An Act relating to Public Health.

Passed 14th April, 1873.

An Act to provide for the repair and improvement of Roads and Bridges, and other Public Works and Services.

An Act to provide for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government of the Province.

An Act to repeal an Act intituled "An Act to amend Chapter 52, Title viii, of Revised Statutes, 'Of Counties, Towns, and Parishes.'"

An Act in amendment of and in addition to the Laws relating to Highways.

An Act to enable the Justices of the Peace for the County of King's County to sell certain Lands.

An Act in amendment of an Act passed in the 35th year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled "An Act to authorize the Town of Portland to raise money by way of loan for the purchase of a Steam Fire Engine and extension of the Fire Alarm Telegraph to the said Town."

An Act respecting the Salaries of Public or Municipal Officers within the Town of Portland.

An Act relating to Auction and other Licenses within the Town of Portland.

An Act to authorize the Roman Catholic Bishop of Saint John to convey certain Lands in the County of Westmorland to the "College of Saint Joseph."

An Act relating to the Police Court and the Court for trial of Civil Causes in the Town of Portland.

An Act to authorize the Trustees of Saint Luke's Church in Bathurst to dispose of certain Lands.

An Act relating to the Marsh at Little Chockpish in Richibucto, in the County of Kent.

An Act to incorporate the Mercantile Insurance Company of Saint John, New Brunswick.

An Act to authorize and empower the County Council of the Municipality of the County of York to issue Debentures to take up certain other Debentures.

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the County of Northumberland to rent a suitable place in the Town of Newcastle for the purposes of a Lock-up House, and to legalize the same.

An Act to incorporate certain Societies of persons called and known by the name of Disciples of Christ, or Christians, in the City of Saint John, and elsewhere, and to repeal 30th Victoria, Chapter 76.
