Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly—

That the Commissioners appointed to construct and superintend the Jolicour Canal in the Parishes of Sackville and Westmorland, in the County of Westmorland, be held, construed and considered to have, and do have under and by virtue of Chapters 67, 68 and 69 of the Revised Statutes, Title x, 'Of Sewers,' full power and authority under the provisions of the said Title x, to construct dykes along each side of said Jolicour Canal to prevent the tidal waters from flowing lands already reclaimed, and shall and do have under the said Title x full power and authority to assess the parties benefited by the building of said dykes, and to collect such assessment; provided, however, that the said Commissioners shall have been previously authorized by a vote of the proprietors interested, at a meeting called for that purpose, to build the said dykes.

Passed 10th April, 1875.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

1. The Ratepayers of the County of Northumberland are hereby made and constituted a body corporate and politic, by the name of "The Municipality of the County of Northumberland," and by that name shall have perpetual succession and a common seal, and may sue and be sued, may hold real and personal property, and shall have and enjoy all the rights and privileges held and enjoyed by Municipalities incorporated under the provisions of Title vi, Chapter 42, of the Revised Statutes, 'Of Municipalities.'

2. In the said County there shall be a County Council, consisting of a Warden and Councillors, to be elected as provided by Chapter 43, of the said Title vi, of the Revised Statutes.

3. The provisions of Chapters 43, 44, 45, 46, and 47, of the said Title vi of the Revised Statutes, (except in so far as the same may have been altered, amended, or repealed,) and any Act altering, amending and repealing the same, or any part thereof, and every other Act heretofore passed since the Revision of the Statutes relating to Municipalities generally, or to the government of Municipalities, or to the election or appointment or government of Municipal or Parish Officers in incorporated Counties, (except the Act 37th Victoria, Chapter 18, intituled *An Act relating to Municipalities*,) are hereby extended to and declared to have and be in full force and effect within the said County of Northumberland, but the said Act 37th Victoria, Chapter 18, shall not so extend or be held to apply to the said County of Northumberland.

4. The Clerk of the Peace of the said County, at the time this Act comes into operation, shall be the Secretary-Treasurer thereof, and shall continue in such last mentioned office, subject to be removed therefrom by the County Council for cause.

5. The Sheriff of the said County of Northumberland is hereby required, on this Act coming into operation, to do and perform all acts by him required to be done under Act of Assembly 19th Victoria, Chapter 37, in like manner as if a Charter had been granted by the Governor in Council for the incorporation of the said County.

6. The word "Rates" in this Act shall mean Parish and County Rates, (including County School Rates.)

7. This Act shall take effect and come into operation on the first day of October next.

3. The provisions of Chapters 43, 44, 45, 46 and 47 of the said Title vi, of the Revised Statutes, except in so far as the same may have been altered, amended, or repealed, and any Act altering, amending or repealing the same, or any part thereof, and every other Act heretofore passed since the revision of the Statutes relating to Municipalities generally or to the government of Municipalities, or to the election or appointment or government of Municipal or Parish officers in incorporated Counties, except the Act 37th Victoria, Chapter 18, intituled *An Act relating to Municipalities*, are hereby extended to and declared to have and be in full force and effect within the said County of Gloucester; but the said Act 37th Victoria, Chapter 18, shall not so extend or be held to apply to the said County of Gloucester.

4. The Clerk of the Peace of the said County at the time this Act comes into operation shall be the Secretary-Treasurer thereof, and shall continue in such last mentioned office subject to be removed therefrom by the County Council for cause.

5. The Sheriff of the said County of Gloucester is hereby required, on this Act coming into operation, to do and perform all acts by him required to be done under Act of Assembly 19th Victoria, Chapter 37, in like manner as if a Charter had been granted by the Governor in Council for the incorporation of the said County.

6. The word "Rates" in this Act shall mean Parish and County Rates, including County School Rates.

7. This Act shall take effect and come into operation on the first day of October next.
