Society, or without the authority or consent of some officer of the Society then present; and any person after notice intruding upon or entering such bounds shall forfeit the sum of two dollars, to be recovered before any Justice of the Peace of the County, on complaint of any officer of the Society, according to the provisions of the one hundred and thirty eighth Chapter of the Revised Statutes, and when recovered shall be paid over to the County Treasurer for the use of the County; provided that nothing herein contained shall extend or be construed to extend to authorize any Agricultural Society to occupy any land without the consent of the owner, or any public highway in such manner as to obstruct the public use thereof.

17th.—The several Agricultural Societies shall be subject to the supervision of the Governor in Council, and shall be account-able thereto; and the Secretary for Agriculture shall have the right to attend the meeting of any Agricultural Society and be present at their deliberations, and also to examine the books and papers of any Society, and take copies of the same as he may think proper; and may, if he deem it necessary, hold an enquiry, under oath, into the affairs and management of any Society.
