In addition to consolidating the Laws now applying to the Methodist Church, the Bill—

1st. Changes the manner of making Trusts of all Trustee Boards uniform, and provides new short Deeds.

2nd. Defines certain terms used in this Bill and in previous Acts.

3rd. Puts the Annual Conference of New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island for certain purposes in the place of the Old Conference of Eastern British America.

4th. Provides for change of the names of Trustee Boards, or their amalgamation, when necessary.

5th. Gives General Conference power to enforce certain Trusts.
