LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL CHAMBER,

FREDERICTON, 5th SEPTEMBER, 1877.

THIS day, at eleven o'clock, His Honor The Honorable SAMUEL LEONARD TILLEY, C. B., Lieutenant Governor of the Province of New Brunswick, came to the Council Chamber, and being seated on the Throne, commanded the attendance of the House of Assembly, who being come, His Honor, after assenting to the several Bills passed during the Session, was pleased to close the Session with the following

S P E E C H :

His Honor then, through the Honorable the President of the Legislative Council, declared the General Assembly prorogued to the second Tuesday in October next.

THE following is a List of the Acts passed at the recent Session of the Legislature:—

Passed 5th September, 1877.

An Act to provide for the expense of holding the present Session of the Legislature.

An Act to incorporate the Moncton Gas Light and Water Company.

An Act to authorize the County Council of the County of Victoria to assess the said County in aid of sufferers by the late Saint John fire.

An Act to authorize the City Council of the City of Fredericton to raise moneys by way of loan, to aid the sufferers by the late fire in the City of Saint John.

An Act to authorize the County Council of the Municipality of the County of York to assess the said Municipality in aid of sufferers by the late Saint John fire.

An Act to enable the Trustees of Saint Andrews Church in the City of Saint John, to sell and convey certain property for Church purposes.

An Act to enable the Saint John Protestant Orphan Asylum to deal with Real Estate.

An Act to authorize the issue by the City Corporation of Saint John in certain cases of City Debentures in substitution of those destroyed in the late fire.

An Act relating to the Parishes in the County of Madawaska.

An Act to provide for an additional Circuit Court to be held in Queen's County for the present year.

An Act to enable Eliza B. M'Laughlin and Daniel J. M'Laughlin, two of the Executors and Trustees of the last Will and Testament of Daniel J. M'Laughlin, deceased, to convey certain lands by way of mortgage, to secure the repayment of certain sums of money to be borrowed thereon for the purpose of reconstructing buildings destroyed by the late great fire in the City of Saint John.

An Act to authorize the County Council of the County of Sunbury to issue Debentures to pay off the debt of the Parish of Burton, and to assess the said Parish for said Debentures.

An Act to amend an Act to incorporate the New Brunswick Masonic Hall Company.

An Act to authorize the Board of Assessors of Taxes in the City of Saint John to grant relief for the present year in cases where taxable property has been destroyed by the recent fire, and to provide for the deficiency in the assessment.

An Act relating to Water Supply and Sewerage in the City of Saint John, and the Town of Portland in the City and County of Saint John.

An Act to incorporate The Saint John Land and House Company.

An Act to provide for rebuilding and replacing public property destroyed by the recent disastrous fire in the City of Saint John.
