CAP. XXVII.

An Act in amendment of the Law of Evidence.

Passed 18th April 1878.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows: -

- 1. Upon any prosecution or proceedings under any Law of the Province for the recovery of any fine or penalty, or for the imposition of any punishment by fine, penalty, or imprisonment, it shall be competent for the person against whom the proceedings are taken to testify in his own defence.
- 2. Such person shall not however be compellable to testify.
- 3. The aforegoing Sections shall also extend and apply to the husband or wife, as the case may be, of the person against whom such proceedings are taken.
