GENERAL RULE.

MICHAELMAS TERM, 45th VICTORIA, 1881.

1. Whenever any Attorney of this Court shall desire to be called to the Bar as a Barrister, he shall apply by Petition to the Court, stating the date of his admission as an Attorney, which Petition shall be filed with the Clerk on or before the first day of the Term in which he intends to apply.

2. Thursday in the first week and Thursday in the third week of each Term, at the opening of the Court on such days, shall be the times for the admission of Barristers; and no Attorney shall be admitted to the Bar at any other time, unless it shall be shewn by affidavit to the satisfaction of the Court, that the person so applying was prevented by reasonable cause from being present at the time appointed.

To Agricultural Societies.

OFFICE OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE,
Fredericton, October 11th, 1881.

THE attention of Officers of Agricultural Societies is directed to the following provision of the Law relating to Agriculture in this Province, 43rd Vict. Cap. XV:—

"2. It shall be the duty of the Officers of every Agricultural Society, in the month of October in each year, to nominate one person suitable for appointment to the Board of Agriculture; and the Secretary of every Society shall, on or before the tenth day of November, transmit to the Provincial Secretary the Name and Address of the person so nominated"; And they are required to govern themselves accordingly.
