Provincial Secretary's Office, Fredericton, May 25 th, 1882. Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled An Act in amendment of Chapter 51 of The Consolidated Statutes, of 'County Courts,' it is provided, that the Governor in Council shall, by Proclamation to be published in the Royal Gazette of this Province, declare the time when the First, Second and Third Sections of the said Act shall come into operation ;—

Now BE IT KNOWN that, by virtue of the power and authority in me vested in and by the said Tenth Section of the said Act, and by and with the advice and consent of my Council, I do hereby proclaim and declare the First day of June next as the time when the said First, Second and Third Sections of the said Act shall come into operation; and that from and after the said First day of June next, the said First, Second and Third Sections respectively of the said Act shall be in force and operation accordingly.
