Timber Regulation.

CROWN LAND OFFICE, 3rd Dec. 1884.

THE attention of the holders of Timber Licenses, and the operators under them, is called to the following Order in Council, passed the 26th day of November, 1884:—

ORDERED—“That all Licensees be notified that if they have any objection to make to the Scale of the Government Scaler, such objection must be made before the Lumber in question leaves the Brows or Landings, so that the objection may be investigated before the Logs or Lumber is driven, otherwise no subsequent claim for over-charge of Stumpage can be entertained by the Government.”

New Timber Applications.

CROWN LAND OFFICE, 3rd Dec. 1884.

LICENSES to expire on the 1st August 1885, for the following Timber Berths, for the purpose of cutting all classes of Lumber, will be sold at this Office, at noon, on Wednesday the 17th day of December next, subject to existing Regulations.

Upset price, \$8.00 per square mile, in addition to Stumpage. No refund of Mileage.

Not to interfere with any recorded sales of land not yet declared cancelled for non-compliance with the Regulations, nor with any Lots now actually occupied and improved to the present value of one hundred dollars, nor with any Lots reserved under applications for which Returns of Survey were received at this Office previous to the date of application for License.

All Timber, Logs or other Lumber cut upon Unlicensed Crown Land or which may be cut by any person beyond the limits of his own Berth, shall be seized and forfeited to the use of the Crown; and no Timber or Lumber shall be cut on any Berth applied for until it shall be purchased at Public Auction.
