Farlane and Catherine M. Farlane, his wife, of the one part, and the said William C. Robinson, of the other part, and for the sale of the lands and premises mentioned and described therein, and for recovery of the possession thereof; and unless such appearance is so entered, the Bill may be taken *pro confesso*, and a Decree made.
