An Act to authorize a Loan to meet the cost of the Importation of Horses, and for other purposes.

An Act to provide for the repair and improvement of Roads and Bridges, and other Public Works and Services.

An Act to provide for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government of the Province.

An Act relating to Interest upon Carleton Branch Railway Debentures in the City of Saint John.

An Act to amend an Act passed in the 49th year of Her present Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to authorize the City Council of the City of Portland to limit the valuation, for Assessment purposes, of certain Lands and Premises in said City."

An Act further to amend the Act to provide for Short-hand Reporting.

An Act to exempt certain property in the Town of Chatham from taxation.

An Act to ratify and confirm a certain Contract made between the Town of Milltown and the Saint Croix Electric Light and Water Company.

An Act to ratify and confirm a certain Contract made between the Town of Saint Stephen and the Saint Croix Electric Light and Water Company.

An Act to protect Highway Bridges.

An Act to change the name of Patrick Devine.

An Act in amendment of and in addition to Chapter 22 of 41st Victoria, intituled "An Act to incorporate the Moncton Gas Light and Water Company."

An Act to incorporate the Newcastle Women's Christian Temperance Union.

An Act relating to certain wharf and other properties of the City Corporation of Saint John.

An Act to extend the provisions of Chapter 33, 46th Victoria, intituled "An Act to exempt certain Manufactories, and the stock, capital and income thereof, in the Town of Saint Andrews, from certain Rates and Taxes."

An Act to provide for an Assessment upon the City of Portland for the maintenance and employment of the Poor of the Almshouse and Workhouse in the City and County of Saint John, omitted in the year 1885.

An Act to amend the Law relating to the Survey and Exportation of Lumber, as relates to the City and County of Saint John.

An Act to incorporate the Upham Hall Company.

An Act to incorporate certain persons to be known as the Women's Christian Temperance Union of Saint John.

An Act to amend an Act to incorporate the Saint Stephen and Milltown Railway Company.

An Act in further addition to an Act passed in the 48th year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act relating to Water Supply in the City of Saint John on the Eastern side of the Harbour, and the City of Portland, in the County of Saint John."

An Act in addition to an Act, intituled "An Act to incorporate the Commissioners of the Almshouse and Workhouse for the City and County of Saint John for certain purposes, and to vest in the Commissioners hereby incorporated certain lands and premises devised in Trust by the late Isabella Grundy to the Overseers of the Poor of the City of Saint John."

An Act to authorize the appointment of a Commission for the amendment of the Law and Practice and the Constitution of the Courts.

An Act to amend Chapter 27 of 48th Victoria, intituled "An Act to authorize the City Council of the City of Portland to fix the valuation of the New Brunswick Cotton Mills (so called) for the purposes of Rates and Taxes for City purposes in said City."

An Act to amend an Act intituled "An Act to incorporate the Tobique Valley Railway Company."

An Act in amendment of Chapter 52 of the Consolidated Statutes, 'Courts of Probate.'

An Act to amend Chapter 110 of the Consolidated Statutes, of 'Fences, Trespasses, and Pounds.'

An Act to incorporate the Woodstock and Centreville Railway Company.

An Act to authorize the Commissioners of Sewerage and Water Supply for Saint John (East) and Portland to effect a loan under special circumstances.

An Act to provide for the appointment of Stipendiary Magistrates, with civil jurisdiction, in the Parishes of Studholm, Norton and Hampton, in the County of King's, and the Parish of Addington, in the County of Restigouche.

An Act to incorporate the Trustees of Sackville Baptist Church, and for other purposes connected therewith.

An Act to enable the Trustees of the Germain Street Baptist Chapel in the City of Saint John to issue Debentures on the security of their corporate property in the City of Saint John.

An Act further to amend the Act intituled "An Act to incorporate the Sheer Boom Improvement Company."

An Act to revive, continue and amend the several Acts relating to the Courtenay Bay Bridge Company.

An Act to provide for the holding of meetings of the Saint John River Log Driving Company.

An Act respecting the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors.

An Act to revive and continue certain Acts relating to Railways in the Counties of Queen's and Sunbury.

An Act to extend and enlarge the Charter of the Buc-touche and Moncton Railway Company.

An Act to provide for the Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages.

An Act to amend 48th Victoria, Chapter 47, intituled "An Act to amend and consolidate the Act 34th Victoria, Chapter 20, incorporating the Town of Saint Stephen, and the several Acts in amendment thereof."

An Act to authorize the Trustees of School District Number One, in the Parish of Salisbury, in the County of Westmorland, to issue Debentures.

An Act to repair certain omissions connected with the Registration of Deeds and other Documents in the County of Gloucester.

An Act to provide for the payment by the City Corporation of Saint John, of certain Carleton Street Debentures.

An Act in amendment of the several Acts relating to the People's Street Railway Company.

An Act to authorize the Northern Railway Company to issue Debentures.

An Act to remove doubts as to the apportionment of County Rates and Taxes in the City and County of Saint John.

An Act to authorize and protect the maintenance of Gates across the New Horton East Aboideau Road, in the Parish of Harvey, Albert County.
