WHEREAS it has been made to appear by affidavit to the satisfaction of me, the undersigned, one of the Judges of the Supreme Court, that Rupert T. Anderson, Earnest L. Anderson, and Jesse A. Anderson, three of the above named defendants, do not reside within the Province, so that they cannot be served with a Summons, and that their place of residence is unknown to the Plaintiff, and that the above plaintiff has good *prima facie* grounds for filing a Bill against the above defendants: I do therefore order, that the said defendants, Rupert T.
