NOTICE is hereby given, that an application will be made to the Local Legislature at its next Session, for the passing of an Act to incorporate a Railway Company for the purpose of constructing and operating a line of Railway from the Terminus of the Temiscouta Railway at Edmundston, in the County of Madawaska, to a point on the Intercolonial Railway, at or near what is known as the Deep Water Terminus of the I. C. R., in the Town of Newcastle, in the County of Northumberland, and thence through the Parishes of Newcastle and Alnwick, in the said County of Northumberland, and the Parish of Saumarez, in the County of Gloucester, to Shippegan Harbour, in said Parish, and connecting with the Caraquet Railway, and power to amalgamate with any other Railway or Company, body corporate or Assigner, Trustee or Lessee of any Railway Company, or otherwise acquire the hire or ownership of any such lines of Railway owned as above named, or to lease its line to any other Railway Company, and with all the usual power necessary or incident thereto.
