

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, of intention to apply by Petition under the provisions of "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Letters Patent Act," for Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, incorporating the applicants and such other persons as may become Shareholders in the Company thereby created, a body politic and corporate under the said Act.

1. The proposed corporate name of the said Company is—"THE PETITCODIAC STEAM NAVIGATION COMPANY."

2. The object for which incorporation is sought is, for the purpose of plying one or more Steamboats on the river Petitcodiac, Shepody Bay, and Bay of Fundy, within the Province of New Brunswick, touching at any point along either bank of the River Petitcodiac, at any point within Shepody Bay, and along the Bay of Fundy on the New Brunswick side as far as and including the City and County of Saint John; and for leasing, purchasing, constructing, establishing, and maintaining all such lands, vessels, engines, machinery, buildings, erections, implements and things, as may be requisite, necessary or convenient for carrying on said business, or incidental thereto.
