An Act to authorize the Commissioners of the General Public Hospital for the City and County of Saint John to provide additional accommodation in the Hospital, and to issue Debentures for carrying out the objects of this Act.

An Act to provide for the building and repairing of Sidewalks in the Upper Road District in the Parish of Woodstock, in the County of Carleton.

An Act to exempt the property of the Algonquin Hotel Company (Limited), in the Town and Parish of Saint Andrews, from certain Rates and Taxes.

An Act to establish the width of Queen Street Extension, in the Town of Saint Andrews at fifty feet.

An Act to incorporate the Presbytery of Miramichi, in the Province of New Brunswick, for the purposes of managing the M'Laggan Trust only.

An Act in addition to and in amendment of Chapter 115 of the Consolidated Statutes, of 'Sewers and Marsh Lands,' so far as relates to the Parish of Westmorland, in the County of Westmorland.
