D. 1890, incorporating W. Turney Whitehead, of Fredericton, in the Province of New Brunswick, Lumber Agent; Hugh H. McLean, of the City of Saint John, in the Province of New Brunswick, Barrister-at-Law; Frank W. Cram, of Bangor, in the State of Maine, in the United States of America, Railway Manager; William D. Winsor, of Philadelphia, in the United States of America, Shipping Merchant; James M. Rhodes, of Philadelphia aforesaid, Banker; William H. Ingham, of Philadelphia aforesaid, Merchant; and Charles H. Wurts, of Philadelphia aforesaid, Physician; for the purpose of promoting the health and recreation of its Members by the pursuit of Fishing and Hunting; to acquire and hold the right to be exercised by the Members to fish in Rivers Tobique and Green, their various branches and lakes at their respective heads; to acquire from time to time, and to hold with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, such real estate as the wants of the Club may require; to lease and sell the real estate belonging to the

Club, or any portion thereof; to sub-let the right it may have to fish in the said Rivers, and to grant permission to such persons as it may see fit to fish in the said Rivers, or to shoot game on its lands, subject to all laws of the Province and Regulations of the Crown Land Department applying to or governing the same; to take such actions or proceedings as may be necessary to protect the fish in the said Rivers, and the game on its lands; to build upon the lands held by the Club all houses or other buildings required from time to time for the accommodation of the Members, and its agents officers and servants; and to improve and develop generally its property in the interest of the Club, by the name of the "TOBIQUE SALMON CLUB," with a total capital of Twenty four thousand dollars, divided into eighty shares of Three hundred dollars each.
