D. 1903, at twelve of the clock, noon, the Lands and Premises mentioned and described in said mortgage as follows:—"All that certain tract, lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Parish of Blissville aforesaid, in the said County of Sunbury, and bounded as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a stake placed on the southern angle of the Grant to Thomas Phillips, Senior, and Jesse Phillips jointly, on the Yoho Stream, thence running by the magnet of the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight north fifty-five degrees west fifty-seven chains to a cedar tree, thence south thirty chains and seventy-five links to a post standing on the northern bank or shore of North West Branch of Oromocto, and thence following the various courses of the said northern bank or shore down stream to the place of beginning, containing one hundred acres more or less, the same having been granted to one John McCluskey by Grant under the Great Seal of
