D. 1903, incorporating Osbert A. Nickerson, of the Town of Yarmouth, in the Province of Nova Scotia, Merchant; Edwin B. Seely, of the City of Saint John, in the Province of New Brunswick, Gentleman; Robert D. Clarke, of the said City of Saint John, Engraver; Herbert J. Smith, of the said City of Saint John, Barrister-at-Law; and Wesley Newton, of the Parish of Grand Manan, in the Province of New Brunswick, Merchant; for the following purposes, namely:—

To carry on the business of engraving, printing, embossing, stamping, painting, book-binding, making and manufacturing bank-notes, stationery and books, together with all such other things as are incident to a general lithographing and printing business.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That the persons hereinafter named will apply to His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, for a grant of a Charter of Incorporation by Letters Patent, under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, according to the provisions of "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, 1893," and Acts in amendment thereof and in addition thereto, incorporating the applicants and such other persons as may hereafter become shareholders in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic, under the name and for the purposes hereinafter set forth.

1. The proposed name of the Company is "VAN BUREN LUMBER COMPANY, Limited."

2. The objects for which incorporation is sought are:

(a) To purchase or otherwise acquire and take over the lumber lands, lumber, licenses, leases, milling property, mills, mill lands, milling rights, store, stock-in-trade and all other property, real and personal, assets, rights and credits, in the County of Madawaska, or elsewhere in the Province of New Brunswick, of the Van Buren Lumber Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Maine, having its head office at Van Buren, in said State, and a branch office at Edmundston, in said Province of New Brunswick, and to continue said business, in all its branches, in said Province of New Brunswick and elsewhere.

(b) To carry on the general lumber and milling business in all its branches, including logging, driving, booming, sawing, manufacturing, shipping, buying, selling, trading and dealing in all kinds and classes of logs, piling, timber and lumber, manufactured and unmanufactured, and all products and by-products thereof, and all products and by-products derived from any operation of the plant of the Company.

(c) To carry on a general store and supply business, and in connection therewith to buy, sell, trade and deal in all kinds and classes of goods, wares and merchandise.

(d) To apply for, take by original grant, buy, purchase, lease, charter or otherwise acquire, and to own, hold, develop, operate, manage and control timber and lumber lands and real estate, and grants, licenses, permits, lumber privileges, water powers, water rights, water privileges, patents of inventions, and rights and interests in patents of inventions, as may from time to time be required or be deemed necessary, convenient or desirable in connection with or incidental to any business of the Company for the purposes herein set forth as objects, purposes or powers, and generally to charter, purchase, take on lease, or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal property, franchises, rights, privileges and powers, and any interest therein, and with power to sell, mortgage, lease, hire or otherwise part with all or any part or parts thereof, and with power also to sell the undertakings of the Company.
