IN THE MATTER OF "THE NEW BRUNSWICK JOINT STOCK COMPANIES' ACT, 1893."

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That application will be made by the applicants hereinafter named, to His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor in Council of the Province of New Brunswick, for a grant of Letters Patent, under the Great Seal according to the provisions of "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies Act, 1893," and amending Acts, constituting the applicants and others who may become shareholders in the Company to be thereby created, a body corporate and politic for the purposes and objects hereinafter mentioned, that is to say:

The proposed name of the Company is "THE ROCK HAVEN HUNTING AND FISHING CLUB, Limited."

The objects for which the incorporation of the proposed Company is sought are:

(a) To organize a general sporting and agricultural club with headquarters in the Parish of Dumfries, in the County of York, and Province of New Brunswick, to promote the health and recreation of its members, and to enjoy fishing, shooting and agricultural pursuits, and to acquire, take over, own and control the club house and property at present owned and operated by Simeon W. Conrad at Chiputneticook Lake, in said Parish of Dumfries, known as "Rock Haven," with the goods, chattels, club furniture and effects, real estate, and personal property thereto belonging and the good-will of said club business.

(b) To purchase, acquire, hold, lease, sell, convey, and dispose of, mortgage or otherwise encumber real estate, and any interest in real estate and in personal estate for the purposes of the said organization.

(c) To build, purchase, charter, lease or otherwise acquire steamers or other vessels and conveyances, using steam or other motive power, and to equip, own, hold, control, manage, sail, charter, let and hire the same for the conveyance of passengers and freight on said Chiputneticook Lake and for other purposes.

(d) To carry, convey or transport passengers and freight of all kinds for hire, and to do the work of common carriers by steamers, vessels and other conveyances in said Chiputneticook Lake.

(e) To mortgage, hypothecate, sell or in any way dispose of all or any of the Company's property, rights, interests or possessions as may be deemed desirable by the Company.

(f) To purchase, acquire and hold real estate for agricultural and sporting purposes to establish game preserves and to conduct and carry on a general sporting and agricultural club.

(g) To do any or all of the things above set forth as objects, purposes or powers or otherwise to the same extent, and as fully as natural persons might or could do as principals, agents, contractors, trustees or otherwise.

(h) To do all and everything incident, usual, necessary, suitable, convenient or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated or incidental to the powers herein named, or which shall at any time appear conducive or expedient for the protection or benefit of the corporation, either as holder of or as interested in any property or otherwise; with all the powers now or hereafter conferred by the laws of the said Province upon corporations under the said Act and the Acts in amendment thereof.

(i) The office or principal place of business is to be at the Parish of Dumfries, in the County of York, in the said Province of New Brunswick.

(j) The amount of the Capital Stock of the Company is to be Six thousand dollars, divided into sixty shares of One hundred dollars each.
