

PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to Thursday, the Twelfth day of February, instant, I have thought fit to dissolve the said Legislative Assembly, and the same is hereby dissolved accordingly.

And I have thought fit further to order and direct that Writs for calling a new Legislative Assembly, to meet on the Fifth day of March next, be forthwith issued in due form, returnable forthwith to our Provincial Secretary at Fredericton.

Given under my Hand and Seal at Fredericton, the fifth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand Nine hundred and three and in the third year of His Majesty's Reign.
