## NOTICE OF GRANTING LETTERS PATENT.

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That under "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, 1893," and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the sixth day of June, A. D. 1904, incorporating Gurney R. Jones, of Lewisville, in the Parish of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick, Farmer; Andrew H. Jones, of the City of Moncton, in said Province, Banker; M. Beer Jones, of said City of Moncton, Broker; Frederick C. Jones, of Lewisville aforesaid, Manufacturer; and William H. Cummins, of Lewisville aforesaid, Manufacturer; for the following purposes, namely:—

To mine, dig, unsoil, produce, prepare, dress, wash, moisten, tread, grind, refine, mould and dry clay, clays, brick clay, fire clay and all other kinds of clays used and employed in the process and manufacture of bricks, house bricks, terra cotta, solids, tiles, drain pipes and other productions therefrom, and to manufacture, press, make, mould, dress, shape and buy, acquire, sell, dispose of and generally deal in bricks, house bricks, terra cotta, solids, tiles, drain pipes and other productions therefrom, and the productions of clays and bricks, and in anything therefrom, by any process of manufacture, reduction or otherwise, and generally to deal in any product resulting from the manufacture of clay, clays, brick clay, fire clay and all other kinds of clay and material, and generally to carry on the manufacture of bricks, house bricks, terra cotta, solids, tiles, drain pipes and other productions therefrom.

To carry on the business of buying, selling, trading, bartering and dealing in all kinds of goods, wares and merchandise, including farm products, both wholesale and retail, and generally to conduct and carry on a general mercantile and supply business in all or any branch of merchandise, buying and selling any and all kinds, classes and description of goods, wares and merchandise, and generally to carry on business as general merchants and traders.

To act as agents in the buying and selling of goods, wares and merchandise or other properties or securities, and to buy and sell on commission.

To purchase, hire, construct or manufacture for use in connection with the business of the Company, any ship, barge, tug-boat, scows, boats, rafts, rolling stock, machinery or plant.

To carry on the business of an Electric Light Company in all its branches, and to generate, use, buy, sell, accumulate, store, transmit, furnish and distribute circuits for light, heat or power, and to manufacture, buy, sell, operate, lease, and let electric light fixtures, supplies and appurtenances used in connection therewith, and to construct, lay down, establish, fix and carry out all necessary cables, wires, lines, accommodations, lamps, appurtenances and appliances in connection therewith.

To enable the said Company, their servants, agents and workmen to enter from time to time upon any public streets, roads, squares, open plots of ground or highways in the Parish of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick, and to dig up and open such public streets, roads, squares, open plots of ground or highways, or any part thereof, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining poles or posts and stringing and maintaining wires for telephones, electric light, heat or power, and renewing and repairing the same.
