PROCLAMATION.

UNDER and by virtue of Section 73 of the Act of Assembly 4 EDWARD VII., Chapter 6, intituled "The Highways' Act, 1904," and pursuant to the power and authority thereby in me vested, I hereby order and declare that the said "The Highways' Act, 1904," shall come into force on, from and after the Sixth day of JANUARY, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five.

Given under my Hand and Seal at Fredericton the Fifth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five, and in the Fourth year of His Majesty's Reign.
