### NOTICE OF GRANTING LETTERS PATENT.

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, That under Chapter Eighty-five of the Consolidated Statutes of New Brunswick, 1903, and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the Great Seal of the said Province, bearing date the twentieth day of November, A. D. 1907, incorporating Charles Edmiston Lockhart, of Notre Dame, in the County of Kent and Province of New Brunswick, Lumberman; Henry Bennett Lockhart, of Leicester, in the County of Cumberland and Province of Nova Scotia, Farmer; Bent Weatherhead Lockhart, of Notre Dame aforesaid, Lumberman; Mary Pamela Lockhart, of Notre Dame aforesaid, Married Woman; and J.
