PROCLAMATION.

UNDER and by virtue of Section 6 of the Act of the Legislative Assembly of the said Province, 7 Edward the Seventh, Chapter 18, intituled "An Act to provide for the erection of Permanent Bridges and also relating to Provincial Debentures," and pursuant to the power and authority thereby in me vested, I hereby Order and Declare that the said "An Act to provide for the erection of Permanent Bridges and also relating to Provincial Debentures," shall come into force and operation upon, from and after the Twenty-fifth day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seven.
