NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That the persons hereinafter named will apply to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, for a grant of a Charter of Incorporation by Letters Patent, under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, according to the provisions of "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, and amending Acts, incorporating the applicants and such other persons as may hereinafter become shareholders in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic, under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned and set forth.

(c) Also for the purpose of its said business to purchase, acquire, lease, hold real and personal property of all kinds, and to sell and dispose of and to convey said real and personal property or any part thereof.
