Also to purchase and acquire stock in-trade, real and personal property, plant, effects and assets of any other person or persons or bodies corporate, now or hereafter carrying on any manufacturing or mercantile business, with the good-will of any such business, or to take security thereon, and to continue such business so acquired or to sell and dispose of the same or the assets thereof.

Also for the purpose of generating and manufacturing electric light power and heat, and selling, supplying and disposing of the same to others.

Also to purchase, lease, acquire, and to have and hold real and personal estate of all kinds including bonds and stock of any incorporated company, and to take, acquire, have and hold security upon any real or personal property or effects whatsoever.
