

## NOTICE OF GRANTING LETTERS PATENT.

**PUBLIC** Notice is hereby given, that under Chapter Eighty-five of the Consolidated Statutes of New Brunswick, 1903, and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the Great Seal of the said Province, bearing date the Third day of June, A. D. 1909, incorporating Edward S. Murdoch, Clergyman; Thomas W. Lawlor, Manager; Peter J. Young, Merchant; J. Gordon Murdoch, Clerk; and Caroline Murdoch, Single Woman; all of Renous Bridge, in the County of Northumberland, in the Province of New Brunswick, for the following purposes, namely:

To purchase, build, erect or otherwise acquire, and to maintain and operate telephone lines and systems throughout the County of Northumberland, in the Province of New Brunswick for the purposes of transmitting by telephone, messages from any point or points within said County, to any other point or points therein, for hire or otherwise over the wires and systems of the said Company, subject, however, to the provisions of Chapter 37 of the Acts of Assembly, 1907, and any other Act of Assembly relating thereto.

For the purpose of its business, to build, purchase, lease, acquire and hold real and personal property of all kinds, and rights, franchises, privileges, concessions, powers and licenses in connection with the said undertaking, with power to sell and dispose of the same, and likewise to mortgage the same from time to time.

To do such other things as may be necessary or incidental to the said business and undertaking, by the name of "Renous

Telephone Company, Limited," with a total Capital Stock of Five thousand dollars, divided into Five hundred shares of Ten dollars each, and with its head office at Renous Bridge, in the County of Northumberland.
