NOTICE is hereby given, that application will be made to His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council, for a Charter of Incorporation by Letters Patent, under the provisions of Chapter 85 of the Consolidated Statutes of New Brunswick, 1903, and amending Acts, incorporating the applicants and such other persons as may become shareholders, in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic, under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned.

1. The proposed corporate name of the Company is "St. John Produce Company, Limited."

2. The objects for which incorporation is sought are:—

(a) To purchase the export business at present carried on in the City of Saint John by F. E. Williams Company, Limited, and to pay for the same in cash or paid-up Capital Stock of the proposed Company, or part one way and part the other as may be agreed upon.

(b) To carry on a general wholesale and retail exporting and importing business, and to buy, sell and deal in every and all kinds of goods, wares and merchandise.

(c) To construct, build, acquire, purchase, exchange, lease, charter, operate, sell, mortgage and hypothecate ships, steamers, barges, lighters and vessels of every nature, for the purpose of carrying on the business of the Company.

(d) To purchase, lease and otherwise acquire, sell, mortgage, or hypothecate, lands and land covered with water, rights, privileges and easements, and to purchase, acquire, construct, maintain and operate docks, wharves, warehouses, canning factories, storage, cold storage, and frost-proof warehouses, and generally to carry on a warehouse, storage, brokerage, agency and factors business.

(e) To promote or assist in promoting, and to become a shareholder in any subsidiary, allied or other company carrying on or having for its object the operation of any business similar to that of this Company, or useful thereto, or which can be operated in connection therewith, and to enter into arrangements for sharing profits, union of interest, joint adventure, reciprocal concessions, or otherwise, with such Company; and to hold, sell, reissue, with or without guarantee, or otherwise deal in the same.

(f) To acquire the good-will, property, rights and assets and assume the liabilities of any person, firm or Company, indebted to the Company, or carrying on or transacting any business similar to that conducted by the Company, and to pay for the same in cash or in securities of the Company or otherwise.

(g) To take or otherwise acquire and hold shares and securities in any other companies authorized to do any business which the Company is authorized to carry on, or carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the Company.

(h) To accept in payment of any work done by the Company or in payment of money due to the Company, stocks, shares, bonds, debentures or other securities of any Company.

(i) To lease, sell, improve, manage, work, develop, exchange, hypothecate, mortgage, turn to account, or otherwise dispose of, or deal with the real and personal property, franchises, rights and assets of the Company or any part thereof, for such consideration as the Company may deem fit, including shares, debentures, or securities of any Company.

(j) To make advances and grant loans on goods, wares, merchandise, produce and effects carried, or to be carried in any vessel, and on goods, wares, merchandise, produce, and personal property of every description, stored or warehoused by the Company, or in connection with the Company's property or business, and to customers and others having dealings with the Company.

(k) To carry on and conduct any other business capable of being carried on in connection with any of the above specified businesses, which may seem calculated to enhance the value, or render profitable any of the Company's property or rights.

3. The Head Office or chief place of business of the Company is to be in the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick.

4. The amount of the capital stock of the Company is to be Forty-nine thousand dollars, (\$49,000.00) to be divided into Four hundred and ninety shares of One hundred dollars each.
