

NOTICE is hereby given, that the persons hereinafter named will apply to His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor in Council for a grant of a Charter of Incorporation by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick according to the provisions of "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act," incorporating the applicants and such other persons as may hereafter become shareholders in the proposed company, a body corporate and politic under the name and for the purposes hereinafter set forth:

1. That the proposed name of the Company is "Barnes & Co., Limited."

2. The objects and purposes for which incorporation is sought are:

(a) To purchase or otherwise acquire and take over the business of printers, publishers, book-binders, stationers, and all other lines of business now carried on in the City of Saint John by George F. Barnes, James W. Barnes, and Eustace Barnes, under the name and style of "Barnes & Co." and all the property, stock in trade, good will, patent rights, copy rights, trade marks and other assets of the said business, and to carry on and continue the said business and to pay for the same in paid-up stock of the Company.

(b) To conduct and carry on the business of general stationers, dealers in and manufacturers of blank books and any and all articles made or dealt in by wholesale or retail stationers and of printing, publishing and selling books, pamphlets, papers and other publications and also to carry on a general job-printing and binding, electrotyping, lithographing, engraving and stereotyping business in all their branches and to do all other work connected with and incidental to a general printing and publishing business, and to manufacture and deal in loose leaf books and loose leaf devices of all kinds and to act as agent for any other persons, firms and corporations.

(c) To purchase or otherwise acquire, take over, own, hold, conduct, carry on and continue the business of any other person, firm or corporation of like or similar lines to the business or businesses above mentioned, or any of them, or of any other capable of being advantageously carried on therewith, with the stock in trade, real and personal property, plant, effects and assets thereof, and the good will of such business and to pay therefor either wholly or partly in paid up shares in the Company or otherwise.

(d) Generally to purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire, or otherwise acquire any real and personal property, and any rights and privileges which the Company may think necessary or convenient for the purposes of its said business.

(e) To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise, and to own and hold real and personal property as may be deemed necessary for the due carrying on of the business of the Company and the same to sell, mortgage, lease, let, hire, pledge, or otherwise encumber or part with, including herein power to sell, lease or encumber the undertaking of the Company or any part thereof or any interest therein.

(f) To acquire by original subscription, purchase or otherwise and to own, hold, manage, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of shares, stock, debentures, bonds or other interest in or obligations of any other incorporated company or body corporate or corporation authorized to issue shares, stock debentures, bonds or other obligations with power, while the holder thereof to exercise all the rights and privileges to ownership including the right to vote thereon.

(g) To acquire by original application, purchase or otherwise any patents, patent rights, copy rights, trade marks or other like rights in connection with the business of the Company.

3. The office or chief place of business of the Company is to be in the City of Saint John in the City and County of Saint John in the Province of New Brunswick.

4. The Capital Stock of the Company is to be Forty-nine thousand dollars divided into Four hundred and ninety shares of One hundred dollars each.
