NOTICE OF LEGISLATION.

NOTICE is hereby given that application will be made at the next session of the Local Legislature of this Province by the Municipality of Gloucester for the passing of Acts as follows:

(1). To authorize the Municipality of Gloucester to issue Debentures for \$25,000 payable in 40 years with interest at 5 p. c. re Northern New Brunswick and Seaboard Railway Co. as per resolutions passed by Council.

(2). To authorize the said Municipality of Gloucester to issue further Debentures to the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars to pay off County indebtedness.

(3). To continue the Act 9 Edward VII Chapter LXXXVII for the further period of one year, so as to continue the borrowing power of the County on temporary loans \$20,000 same as last year.

All these resolutions passed by the Gloucester Municipal Council.
