### THE SUPREME COURT IN EQUITY.

Between Samuel Johnson, Plaintiff; and James F. Ritchie, Michael Doolan and Margaret Doolan his wife, Robert J. Ritchie and Mary A. Ritchie his wife, Thomas H. Ritchie, Marmaduke F. Ritchie and Anne Ritchie his wife, Charles E. Ritchie and Lena Ritchie his wife, Joseph H. Ritchie and Eugenia M. Ritchie his wife, Catherine Ritchie and Catherine Ritchie the Younger, Defendants.

WHEREAS it has been made to appear by affidavit to the satisfaction of me, the undersigned, one of the Judges of the Supreme Court, that the above named defendant, James F. Ritchie, does not reside within the Province, so that he cannot be served with a Summons, and that his place of residence cannot be ascertained by the plaintiff, and that the above named plaintiff has good *prima facie* grounds for filing a Bill against the above named defendants: I do order, that the said defendant, James F.
