

## CROWN LAND OFFICE, 9th August, 1893.

**T**HE right of License to cut all classes of Lumber until the first day of August, 1894, on Crown Lands which were recently under License to the undermentioned persons, will be offered for Sale at Public Auction, agreeably to existing Regulations.

The Sale will be held at this Office, and will commence at 11 o'clock, A. M., on

**TUESDAY THE 29TH DAY OF AUGUST INSTANT,**

and be continued from day to day until all advertised ground has been offered.

Licenses will be sold, not to interfere with any recorded sales of lands not yet declared cancelled for non-compliance with the Regulations under which they were purchased, nor with any lots now actually occupied and improved to the value of forty dollars (\$40.00), nor with any lots reserved under application, for which returns of Survey were received at this Office previous to the first day of July, 1893.

*Upset Price for Mileage.*

Eight dollars (\$8.00) per Square Mile, in addition to Stumpage.

*No Refund of Mileage.*

All Licenses purchased at competition must be paid for in Cash (or approved Checks) immediately after being bid off; and all Licenses purchased at upset price must be paid for immediately after the close of the Sale.

Any changes made in the description of any License, which has altered the contents of the same, because of new surveys, or by withdrawal of any lots, or for any other reason, can be ascertained on application at this Office.

The Licenses north of the S. W. Miramichi River, on Dungarvon and Renous Rivers, and in that vicinity, will be sold to conform with the Blocks defined by Dy. Freeze's Survey in 1892.

In the event of future Surveys made under directions from this Office, showing changes in the contents and positions of Blocks as now shown, the Surveyor General reserves the right to alter the description of any License that may be purchased at this Sale, so as to make the same conform with Blocks as ascertained by such Survey.

**NOTE.**—Beside the Crown Lands that were recently under License, and which are advertised below, there are large portions of vacant and unapplied for Timber Lands belonging to the Crown, Licenses of which may be obtained in the usual way, viz. by applying for any such lands, describing the same, and depositing the upset price of \$8.00 for each square mile required. Sale of such applications for Timber Licenses will be made after fourteen days' notice.
