PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to Thursday, the Third day of October next, I have thought fit to dissolve the said General Assembly, and the same is hereby dissolved accordingly.

And I have thought fit further to order and direct that Writs for calling a new General Assembly, to meet on Thursday the Twenty eighth day of November next, be forthwith issued in due form, returnable forthwith to our Provincial Secretary at Fredericton.

Given under my hand and Seal at Fredericton, the Twenty sixth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety five, and in the fifty ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
