

WHERE LICENSES LAPSE.

34. In case for any cause the license becomes void, or in case the term or interest of the holder of a license in the premises licensed ceases before the expiry of the license, or if such licensee absconds or abandons the premises, or becomes insolvent, the License Commissioners may grant a new license for the same premises, subject to the provisions of this Act, upon such terms as to the payment or refund by the new licensee of the duty for the unexpired period to the person entitled thereto under the original license, as to the License Commissioners may seem just.

DUTIES PAYABLE.

35. The following license duties shall hereafter be payable, and shall, subject to the provisions of the next section, be in lieu of all others, Provincial or Municipal, that is to say:—

- 1—For Wholesale Licenses in Cities and Towns containing a population of 20,000 and upwards, for each license.....\$250
- For Wholesale Licenses in Cities and Towns containing a population of more than 10,000 and less than 20,000..... 200
- For Wholesale Licenses in Cities and Towns containing a population of more than 5,000 and less than 10,000.... 150
- For Wholesale Licenses in Cities and Towns containing a population of less than 5,000..... 150
- In other districts..... 75
- For each Wholesale License to a Brewer..... 400
- 2—For each tavern license in Cities and Towns containing a population of 20,000 and upwards.....\$150
- For Hotels in such Cities and Towns..... 200
- For each Tavern license in Cities and Towns containing a population of 5,000 and less than 20,000..... 150
- For each Tavern license in Cities and Towns containing a population of less than 5,000..... 150
- For each Tavern license in other districts the duty shall be fixed by the Board of License Commissioners of the district subject to the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.
- 3—For every transfer or removal of a license..... 50
- 4—For each license for a Club..... 150

36. Over and above the duties for licenses hereinbefore imposed, there shall be paid, in order to the raising of a revenue for Provincial purposes, the following additional duties thereon:

- 1—For each wholesale license in Cities and Towns containing a population of 20,000 and upwards.....\$250
- For each wholesale license in Cities and Towns containing a population of more than 10,000 and less than 20,000..... 200
- For each wholesale license in Cities and Towns containing a population of more than 5,000 and less than 10,000..... 150
- For each wholesale license in Cities and Towns containing a population of less than 5,000..... 50
- For each wholesale license in other districts..... 75
- For each wholesale license to a Brewer..... 400
- 2—For each tavern license in Cities and Towns containing a population of 20,000 and upwards..... 150
- For hotels in such Cities and Towns..... 200
- For each tavern license in Cities and Towns containing a population of 5,000 and less than 20,000..... 125
- For each tavern license in Cities and Towns of less than 5,000 50
- 3—For each tavern license in other districts the duty shall be fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.
- For each license for a Club..... 150

(2) The population of a City for the purposes of this and the preceding section shall be determined according to the then last Dominion census.
