Any Dentist or Dental Surgeon practising dentistry in any form in the Province of New Brunswick, whose name does not appear in the above list, is not registered as per Section 18 of the "New Brunswick Dental Act, 1890," and is liable to prosecution under said Act, and cannot legally collect fees for services rendered, as per Section 30 of "N. B. Dental Act, 1890," which reads as follows:—"No person shall be entitled to recover any charges in any Court of Law for services as Dentist or Dental Surgeon, or for any medicines which he shall have both prescribed and supplied, unless he shall prove upon trial that at the time the services were performed, or the medicines prescribed and supplied, he was registered under this Act."

The following is a list of the Acts passed at the recent Session of the Legislature:—

Passed 21st February, 1898.

An Act to amend the Act 45 Victoria, Chapter 34, intituled "An Act in aid of the construction of Railways and other Works in this Province."

An Act in amendment of the Act incorporating "The Corporation of the Saint John Rural Cemetery Company."

Passed 18th March, 1898.

An Act to amend the Law respecting the appointment of Queen's Counsel.

An Act to provide for the appointment of Provincial Constables.

An Act relating to the Assessment for Water Supply in the City of Saint John.

An Act to authorize an assessment in the City of Saint John to meet the expenses incurred by the Corporation for the celebration of the Sixtieth year of the Reign of Her Majesty the Queen.

An Act to amend Chapter 46 of the Consolidated Statutes, 'Witnesses and Evidence.'

An Act to authorize the Municipality of King's to grant exemption from taxation, for a period of ten years, of the Buildings, Works, Plant and Property of "The Ossekeag Stamping Company" at Hampton.

An Act to amend Chapter 95 of the Consolidated Statutes, of 'Lien of Watchmakers and Jewellers.'

An Act to amend an Act intituled "An Act to incorporate the Exhibition Association of the City and County of Saint John."

An Act to amend the Act 46 Victoria, Chapter 46, intituled "An Act relating to the election of Churchwardens and Vestrymen of Trinity Church in the Parish of Saint John, in the City of Saint John."

An Act relating to Saint Joseph's College, and to change the name thereof to "The University of Saint Joseph's College."

An Act to authorize the Municipality of Northumberland to effect Temporary Loans.

An Act to amend an Act to incorporate The New Brunswick Masonic Hall Company.

An Act to authorize The Saint John Bridge and Railway Extension Company to issue Debentures for the purpose of paying off its maturing loans.

An Act to enable the Trustees of the First Moncton Baptist Church in the City of Moncton, to issue Debentures on the security of their corporate property in the City of Moncton to pay outstanding Debentures and other indebtedness.

An Act relating to "The Free Christian Baptist General Conference of New Brunswick," and to change the name thereof to "The Free Baptist General Conference of New Brunswick."

An Act to incorporate the Village of Andover for Water and Fire purposes.

An Act to enable the County Council of the Municipality of Westmorland to sell and convey certain lands in the Parish of Salisbury, held for School purposes.

An Act in further amendment of the Act 53 Victoria, Chapter 4, intituled "An Act respecting Practice and Proceedings in the Supreme Court in Equity."

An Act to further amend Chapter 63 of the Consolidated Statutes, of 'Coroners' Inquests.'

An Act to aid in the settlement of Crown Lands in the Province.

An Act for the further encouragement of Agriculture.

An Act to amend Chapter 58 of the Consolidated Statutes, and to give Civil Jurisdiction to the Stipendiary Magistrate of Kent County.

An Act to grant aid towards holding of a Provincial Exhibition.

An Act to encourage the visits of Tourists and Sportsmen to the Province.
