PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That the applicants hereinafter named will, after the expiration of two weeks from the publication of this notice, apply by petition to His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor in Council of New Brunswick, for the issue of Letters Patent under the provisions of "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, 1893," and amending Acts, incorporating the applicants and such other persons as may hereafter become shareholders in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic, under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned.

(a) That the proposed name of the Company is the "MARITIME GLASS COMPANY, (Limited)."

(b) That the purposes and objects for which the incorporation of the Company is sought are—The carrying on of a general ornamental Glass manufacturing business in all its branches, including the bending of glass, the staining of glass, the silvering of glass for mirrors, the sand cutting of glass, the embossing of glass, the wheel cutting of glass, leaded Art glass, and the manufacture of moulded, pressed, cut and ground glass, and all articles made from the same.
