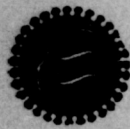

READERS.—The First Primer of a new series of Readers to be known as "The New Brunswick Readers," is authorized for use at the opening of the Schools in August, proximo. The Board has also provided for the gradual introduction of the whole of said Series after such intervals in the case of each grade as shall, so far as possible, allow time for the books now in use to be exhausted.
