

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That application will be made by the applicants hereinafter named, to His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, for a Grant of Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Province of New Brunswick, according to the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly of the said Province, 56 Victoria, Chapter 7, intituled "The New Brunswick Joint Stock Companies' Act, 1893," and Acts in amendment thereof, incorporating applicants and such other persons as may hereafter become shareholders in the proposed Company, a body corporate and politic, under the name and for the purposes hereinafter mentioned.

1. The proposed corporate name of the Company is, "THE MCFARLANE, NEILL MANUFACTURING COMPANY, Limited."

2. The objects for which the incorporation of the Company are sought, are:

(a) To purchase, acquire, take over, hold and operate the Factory, machinery and manufacturing business conducted at Saint Marys, in the County of York and Province of New Brunswick, by the late Walter McFarlane at the time of his death, and since then by his Estate, together with the good will of the said manufacturing business, the patent rights protecting the manufacture and sale of certain articles, and the stock, manufactured and unmanufactured, in connection with said business.

(b) To manufacture, produce, buy, sell, trade and deal in, at wholesale and retail, Peaveys, Peavey Handles, Cant Dogs, and Handles, Hames, Boot Calks, Steel Balls, and all kinds of drop forgings, Axes, Scythes and all kinds of edge tools, Hinges, Door Hangers, and all kinds of Hardware, Bolts, Nuts, Washers, Spikes, Nails, Tacks, Shovels, Rakes, Hay Forks, Ploughs, Hay Rakes, Mowing Machines, Reapers, Harrows, Horse Hay Forks, Tackle Blocks, Carriers and Track, and all kinds of farming and harvesting machinery and parts thereof, Carriages, Waggon, Pungs, Sleighs, Sleds and all kinds of vehicles and all parts thereof, Horse Shoes, Horse Shoe Nails and Toe Calks in Iron and Steel, Stoves, Ranges, Furnaces and all kinds of castings, and all kinds of machinery, tools implements, and articles of iron, steel or any other metals, or metals, or of wood, or of their products.

(c) To purchase, acquire, lease, build, sell, mortgage, convey and assign any and all lands, buildings, foundrys, machine shops, factories and premises necessary or convenient for the purpose of carrying on the Company's business. To purchase, deal in, and sell, by wholesale and retail, all kinds of goods, wares and merchandise necessary or convenient for the carrying on of a general manufacturing and mercantile business.

(d) To acquire, purchase, use, hold, sell and dispose of any rights under Letters Patent, franchises, patents and their rights and rights in lands, tenements and hereditaments necessary or convenient for conducting or benefitting the business of the proposed Company.

(e) To acquire the good will of any business within the purposes and scope of the Company, and any lands, tenements and hereditaments and privileges, rights and powers appertaining to the same.

(f) To mortgage or to sell and dispose of the whole or any part of the property or rights of the proposed Company to any other Company, Corporation, person or persons.

(g) To carry on any other business whether manufacturing or otherwise which may seem to the Company capable of being carried on with the aforesaid businesses or any of them, or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of the Company's property or rights.

(h) To buy, sell, lease, sink, dig and bore artesian and other wells, erect and build dams, reservoirs, stand pipes, piers and pumping stations, and all other erections necessary, or convenient for securing and maintaining water supply, and to construct, build and lay aqueducts and water pipes, and to lease and sell the same, or the water supplied and furnished by means thereof.

(i) To do any and all things above set forth as objects, purposes or otherwise, and any and all things necessary, suitable, convenient, desirable or proper, for the accomplishments of the purposes, or the attainment of any one or more of the objects enumerated, or incidental to the powers hereinbefore named, or which shall or may at any time appear conducive or expedient to such accomplishment or attainment, or for the benefit of the company, either as holders of, or interested in, any property or otherwise, as well without as within the said Province to the same extent, and as fully as natural persons might or could do.

3. The office or place of business of the Company is to be at Saint Marys, in the County of York, in said Province of New Brunswick.

4. The amount of the proposed Capital Stock of the said Company to be \$100,000 and to be of two classes, namely: "A" Stock, being ordinary Stock of the Company for the sum of \$75,000 divided into 750 shares of \$100 each; and "B" Stock, being preference Stock, which shall be of two kinds, namely: First preference Stock and Second preference Stock; First preference Stock to be for the sum of \$5,000, consisting of fifty shares of \$100 each. Such First preference Stock shall have preference and priority as respects dividends and in the distribution of assets over the Second preference Stock, and over the ordinary Stock of the Company, the holders of such First preference Stock to be entitled to receive a dividend thereon at the rate of six per centum per annum payable out of the profits of the Company half yearly before any dividend shall be declared upon and paid to the holders of the Second preference Stock, or of the ordinary Stock of the Company.

The second preference Stock to be for the sum of \$20,000, divided into 200 shares of \$100 each, which Second preference Stock shall have preference and priority as respects dividends, and in the distribution of assets over the ordinary Stock of the said Company, the holders of such Second preference Stock to be entitled to receive a dividend thereon at the rate of five per centum per annum payable out of the profits of the Company half yearly before any dividend shall be declared upon and paid to the holders of the ordinary Stock of the Company.
