WHEREAS it has been made to appear, by affidavit, to the satisfaction of me, the undersigned, one of the Judges of the Supreme Court, that the above named defendants, Alexander Loudoun and John Loudoun, do not reside within the Province so that they cannot be served with a Summons, and that their place of residence cannot be ascertained by the plaintiff, and that the above plaintiff has a good prima facie grounds for filing a Bill against the above named defendants: I do hereby order, that the said defendants, Alexander Loudoun and John Loudoun, on or before
