PROCLAMATION.

A. R. McCLELAN.

Whereas, the obsequies of
Her Late Majesty, Queen
Victoria of Blessed Memory
take place on Saturday, the
second day of February in-
stant;

I do therefore hereby pro-
claim the said Second day of
February instant, to be a Pub-
lic Holiday, and a day of gen-
eral mourning to be observed
by all persons throughout our
Province of New Brunswick.

Given under my hand and Seal at Fredericton,
the first day of February, in the year of our
Lord one thousand nine hundred and one, and
in the first year of His Majesty's Reign.
